## How to get from the airport (Lidosta) to the city center

Take the **bus N°22** (The stop is right outside the airport)

You can buy a ticket inside the bus22 by card (1,81 EUR)

Or you can buy 90min ticket at the Narvesen kiosk or the ticket machine (1.50 EUR)

TIP: buy several tickets in advance to save time later!

How to get to ATTA CENTRE Address: <u>Krasta iela (street) 60</u>

Bus N°12 (direction: Ziedonis)

Starting from the city center, take the bus to Balvu iela (~7 min). From there, it's an 8-min walk to the Atta Centre

Trolleybus N°15 (direction: <u>Kengarags</u>)

From the city center, go to Rēznas iela stop (~13min). From there, it's around 11 min walk to the venue

## Tram N°7 (direction: <u>Kengarags</u>)

From the city center, go to Rēznas iela stop (~12min). Walk ~8mins to the Atta centre

## Tips on public transport in Rīga

TICKETS: there is electronic ticketing system **e-talons** 

Tickets can be purchased from ticket machines or Narvesen kiosks or some shops. For a complete list of locations, click here <u>ej.uz/tickets\_Riga</u>

You cannot purchase tickets on the transport. (except for bus  $N^{\circ}22$ , which goes to the airport)



- If you see this sign at the stop, it indicates a 'request stop.'
  - Make sure you are visible to the driver at the stop.
  - Or press the 'stop' button before reaching the stop if you wish to get off.

You can rent a car in car-sharing (see your options here: <u>www.ej.uz/carsharing\_Riga</u>)

Note: Both options cost less when used outside the airport zone in the city.
